**John Albert. "Spanky" Bearden** Former Lexington County Clerk of Court WEST COLUMBIA - John A. "Spanky" Bearden, 62, of West Columbia, passed into His heavenly home on Friday, December 6, 2013, after an extended illness. Born in Laurens, SC, he was a son of Dorothy Bearden Mullinax of Fountain Inn, And d the late John Madison Bearden, Jr. Mr. Bearden made West Columbia his home after relocating from Greenville County to begin his public service career with the S.C. State Highway Patrol as well as the S.C. National Guard. He continued his public service as a Sheriff's Deputy with the Lexington County Sheriff's Department. While a Deputy, he touched many children's lives as Traffic and Safety Officer and was known as "Deputy Spanky." Mr. Bearden continued to publicly serve the County after being elected for two terms as Lexington County Clerk of Court. He continued his ambitions as Court Supervisor with the City of Columbia Court System. Mr. Bearden later entered into his retirement after employment with Allied Barton Security.

He was a member and Past Master of Sinclair Masonic Lodge #154 with dual membership at Eau Claire Masonic Lodge #344. He was a member of the York Rite Bodies and served as Secretary/Recorder of the Columbia York Rite. Mr. Bearden continued his faithful service as a member with Palmetto York Rite College #70, Columbia AMD, Chancellor Commander of Knights of Pythias, Tall Cedars of Lebanon, and Samuel H.J. Womack Council #20 Knight Masons.

Mr. Bearden served as an Advisor with the Palmetto DeMolay, an Advisory Board Member with the West Columbia Order of the Rainbow for Girls, a Boy Scout Leader and an Advisor for Lexington County Explorers. In the early stages of his illness, he gave of his time in initiating the formation of the first Liver Foundation at the Lexington Medical Center. Mr. Bearden was an active member of Fellowship Baptist Church and attended the Prime Timer's Sunday School Class. He enjoyed his church and referred to the members as his extended family.

He often spoke of his love for "good ole country gospel music." He was an avid fan of westerns and a John Wayne enthusiast. He had a vast collection of the actor's television and movie performances as well as photo memorabilia. He enjoyed watching the past performances of the actor and knew most of the movies by heart. Mr. Bearden was an accomplished cook and could recite recipes by memory.

Even while in the ICU, he would unselfishly give nurses his prized recipes. He would laugh and say that having "two cooks in the kitchen" at his family home did not prove to be an asset.

Mr. Bearden gave a 'Gift of Body Donation' to the University of S.C. School of Medicine and Anatomical Program. It was his wish that others would benefit from his contribution to medical science.

Surviving Mr. Bearden are his wife of thirty-seven years, Deborah Hartley Bearden, and a son, John Christian (Chris) Bearden. In addition to his mother are siblings, Marian Owens, Loretta Perry and Kirk Bearden.

A memorial service to celebrate Mr. Bearden's life will be held on Saturday, December 14, 2013, at 2:00 p.m. at Fellowship Baptist Church in West Columbia. The family will receive friends at the church immediately following the service. Rev. Don Bell and Rev. Phares Chatham will be conducting the service. It was Mr. Bearden's desire to have Masonic rites at the service and his Masonic brothers recognized.

The family wishes to thank all of the doctors and nurses who provided loving and compassionate care during Mr. Bearden's extended illness.
